KNOWN ALLERGIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS:

ONEIGHTY is committed to conducting their recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regards. We strive to reduce risk of injury and insist that all participants follow safe skating practices.

HELMETS WILL BE WORN AND SECURELY BUCKLED WHILE SKATING WITH NO EXCEPTIONS

Participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for the ONEIGHTY SkatePark must recognize there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in skating of any kind. Parents/Guardians are solely responsible for determining if their minor child is physically fit and/or adequately skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

WARNING OF RISK

Skateboarding, inline skating, and maneuvering scooters are activities that challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment there is still risk of serious injury. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers may be foreseen. Because all types of skating are done with little protective equipment and because it puts great demands on stamina, the very nature of skating is hazardous and risky. Such risk and dangers include but are not limited to; skating on an irregular riding surface, losing balance, attempts to perform stunts, skateboard slipping out from under the rider or the skates sliding out from under the rider, scooter slipping out from under the rider, tripping, loss of control, colliding with other riders or stationary objects, acts of God, including weather, lack of safety equipment or failure of equipment, failure in supervision, and all other circumstances inherent to the sport of skating. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for ONEIGHTY or its staff to guarantee absolute safety.

I have read the above statement and recognize and acknowledge there are risks of physical injury to participants in skating activities, and I voluntarily agree to assume the risk of any injuries, damages, or loss regardless of severity that my minor child or I may sustain as a result of participating in the activities connected with or associated with this program/activity.

I do hereby fully release and forever discharge all parties from any and all claims for injuries, damages or loss that may accrue to me or my minor child arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with this program/activity. I also discharge any and all claims against Effingham Oneighty, Oneighty National Headquarters, and their employees and volunteers.

I have read and fully understand the above important information and warning of risk statements. I have also read the above and explained it to my minor child. I do hereby release all parties from any liability arising out of, or connected with the ONEIGHTY SkatePark.

I understand that in an emergency, the 180 leadership will attempt to contact me immediately. In the event that I am not available and medical treatment is necessary, I give my permission to the ONEIGHTY leadership to obtain the services and treatment from a licensed physician.

180 SKATEPARK RULES**

- Use wisdom and stay focused.
- Helmets must be worn and be securely buckled while skating with no exception.
- Unless otherwise instructed by the 180 SkatePark staff, other safety equipment (elbow, knee, wrist protection) is optional and left to the discretion of the participant and their skill level.
- Horseplay, shoving, and/or fighting will not be tolerated.
- Obey and respect all Skateboard staff and leadership.
- Do not proceed down a ramp until clear of other skaters.
- No bicycles or roller skates allowed in the park.
- Spectators must stay clear of skaters and equipment.
- Only one person per skateboard.
- Only registered skaters who have completed the necessary forms are allowed to skate. Allowing your unregistered friends or others to borrow your skateboard may revoke your privileges to use the park.
- Food and drink are not allowed inside the SkatePark area.
- No smoking.
- Profanity will not be tolerated.
- No alcohol, controlled substances, or weapons on property.
- No glass in or around the SkatePark

I have read this list of rules and agree to follow them at all times. I understand that my failure to follow these rules or my failure to obey and respect the SkatePark security personnel and staff will revoke my right to use the SkatePark for a period of time as determined by the security staff and leadership of ONEIGHTY.
